### WHO CAN APPLY?

To be considered for a WesTrac apprenticeship you must be over 16 years of age at the time of commencement. Apprentices are required to get themselves to and from work each day as well as to and from our Tomago Head Office (near Newcastle) for training. We recommend applying once you have a licence and reliable transport to be able to meet this requirement.

WesTrac has a diverse team and we welcome applications from mature age applicants, all genders and cultural backgrounds.

As part of the recruitment process you may be required to undergo a national police check and pre-employment medical if your application progresses to the final stages.




